Next Tuesday we will depart from Germany via Singapore to Fiji. We will arrive Friday afternoon 23th of February on the Island. We try to be active a few hours after our arrival.

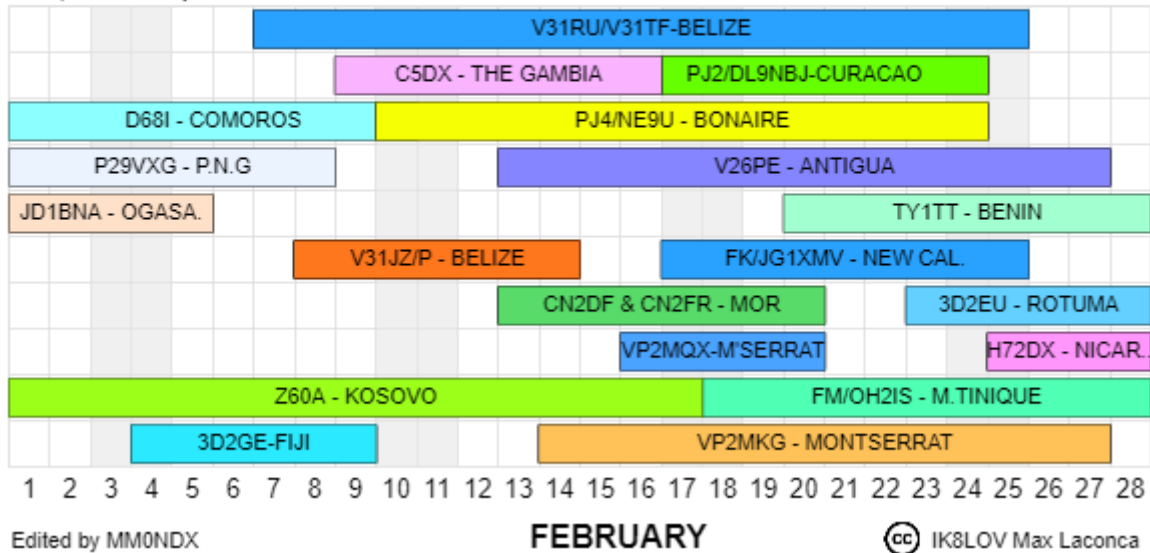
